NOTICE FOR SCHLOARSHIP BY ALUMNI

Category 1: STUDENTS ADMITTED IN YEAR 2015-16 (B.E. First Year) AND ARE IN FINAL YEAR B.E IN 2018-19

Category 2: STUDENTS ADMITTED IN YEAR 2016-17 (B.E. First Year) IN RCOEM AND ARE IN THIRD YEAR B.E IN 2018-19

Category 3: STUDENTS ADMITTED IN YEAR 2017-18 (B.E. First Year) IN RCOEM AND ARE IN SECOND YEAR B.E IN 2018-19

Applications are invited from eligible students from above three categories for the scholarship programme sponsored by Mr.Amit Jain, Alumni of RCOEM and Director, Mahagun India Private Limited.

Key Features of Scholarship:

1. The scholarship amount is Rs.50, 000/- per year each for five students. The scholarship will be given for four years (successful graduation) provided students meet the required eligibility criteria.
2. The scheme is open to only **Undergraduate Engineering students of RCOEM in above two categories** who fulfill the eligibility criteria as laid down herein below.
3. The Scholarship amount will be disbursed by the company to students concerned directly.
4. In this scheme, a duly constituted committee of the Institute assesses the economic condition/financial requirements of the applicants' parents/family. **Based on recommendation of the committee, financial assistance will be granted to such students on merit basis only.**
5. The submission of application for consideration of the request for financial assistance does not create any right in the applicant for the grant of financial assistance. In all

cases, the grant of financial assistance is subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria for grant of financial assistance, the consideration of the duly constituted committee and the approval of the Competent Authority. The decision of the Competent Authority will be final and no request for reconsideration of the recommendation of the committee will be entertained.

6. **Selection of the students will be strictly based on merit.**
7. The Competent Authority along with the core committee is empowered to make amendments in overall conduction of the scheme.
8. The Institute is only facilitator between Scholarship provider (Alumni) and beneficiary (student). The Institute will not be responsible for any discrepancy in future.
9. The Competent Authority will be Principal of the Institute.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. **Category 1: The applicant should be a regular student of the Institute admitted in the year 2015-16 in first year B.E. and have cleared Second year B.E. in 2016-17, Third year in 2017-18 (All semesters in first attempt with minimum CGPA 8)**
Category 2: The applicant should be a regular student of the Institute admitted in the year 2016-17 in first year B.E. and have cleared First year B.E. in 2016-17, Second year B.E. in 2017-18 (All semesters in first attempt with minimum CGPA 8)
Category 3: The applicant should be a regular student of the Institute admitted in the year 2017-18 in first year B.E. and have cleared First year B.E. in 2017-18 in first attempt minimum CGPA 8.
2. Students should be from economically weaker sections of the society having the total family income not exceeding Rs. 3.00 Lakhs p.a. or differently abled persons or orphans/children of armed forces who have lost their lives on duty.
3. The applicant/applicant's family should hold an Income Certificate issued by the officer authorized in this behalf by the Revenue Department/Collector Office that the total annual income of the family is not more than Rs. 3.00 Lakhs p.a. The date of issue of Income Certificate should be in the year 2017-18.
4. Every applicant shall be required to submit application on prescribed format, with all requisite documents enclosed, on or before the closing date of this scheme.
5. **Note that following students/applicants shall not be eligible for grant of financial assistance under this scheme:**

- a) An applicant availing any kind of financial assistance or scholarship from any other sources of the Government**
- b) The student who has the status of failure in any of the subjects in any of the semesters on the last date of submission of application form.**
- c) The applicant detained in any semester examination of the course due to shortage of attendance.**
- d) The applicant penalized by the institute for any act of indiscipline during the course.**
- e) The students who have cleared any semester in Make up Exams.**
