Subject: Re-registration of back-log PG courses of CBCS Scheme

The revised PG Ordinance No. 13.5 (available on page 43, PG ordinances/regulations, college website) is as follows.

If a student is eligible for 'FF', 'Z' or 'I' grade in a course, he/she shall be eligible to re-register for that course whenever the course is offered again.

Re-registration shall be mandatory for the course in which the student was detained i.e. eligible for 'Z' grade.

Re-registration for the course shall mean that the student shall have to take up the course again along-with the regular courses in the current semester. His/her previous performance in the re-registered course including continuous evaluation and attendance shall be treated as null & void and the student shall be considered as a fresh candidate for that course.

Students should note the following:

- (1) **Anyone who re-registers for a course in the present Even Semester 2017-18 and onwards, his/her previous performance including continuous evaluation and attendance in that course shall become null and void and the student shall be treated as a fresh candidate for that course and only the fresh attendance & internal assessment shall be treated as final.**
- (2) **Total Examination Fees for Ex-Student of PG CBCS Programmes who are re-registering for back-log courses will be equal to the (usual examination fee as per college norms plus Rs. Five hundred per re-registered course) payable together at the time of re-registration.**
- (3) **Concerned students should contact their respective M.Tech Coordinator who will then convey to GEMS incharge for inclusion of such cases in GEMS.**
