Eligibility Criteria for MINORS Scheme at the time of Registration (III Semester)

1. Students should fulfill following criteria at the time of registration
Regular Students:
 - a. Students having CGPA more than or equal to 6.75 in till I and II Semester
 - b. Student should not have received 'Z' grade in any of the previous courses (I and II Semester)**Diploma Students:**
 - a. Students having CGPA more than or equal to 6.75 in Diploma.
2. Students should not have any backlog in II Semester. If he/she has live backlog in II Semester, he/she should get it clear in the immediate make up exam. Till that time he/she can attend Honors/Minors classes, but registration will be confirmed only after Make Up Exam result.
3. Unfair Means Students are not allowed to register at any moment during the entire Honors/Minors Program.
4. Students will be allowed only two chances to pass the Honors/Minor course i.e. regular End Semester Examination and its immediately followed Make-up examination. If a student is not able to pass the course in these examinations, no additional chance shall be given as ex-student at any stage and he/she will be discontinued from the honors/Minor scheme.

Eligibility Criteria for MINOR Scheme in Higher (IV, V, VI, VII) Semesters

Semester	Eligibility criteria for registration of Minor Course
IV	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students having CGPA more than or equal to 6.75 till III Semester2. Student must have cleared all subjects of First Year in maximum TWO (Regular and immediate Make up) attempts3. Minimum BC grade in Minor course of III Semester.4. Student should not have received 'Z' grade in any of the courses of III Semester.
V	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students having CGPA more than or equal to 6.75 till IV Semester2. Student must have cleared all subjects till Second Year in maximum TWO (Regular and immediate Make up) attempts3. Minimum BC grade in Minor course of IV Semester.4. Student should not have received 'Z' grade in any of the courses of IV Semester.
VI	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students having CGPA more than or equal to 6.75 till V Semester2. Student must have cleared all subjects of Second Year in maximum TWO (Regular and immediate Make up) attempts.3. Minimum BC grade in Minor course of V Semester.4. Student should not have received 'Z' grade in any of the courses of V Semester.

VII	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students having CGPA more than or equal to 6.75 till VI Semester 2. Student must have cleared all subjects of Third Year in maximum TWO (Regular and immediate Make up) attempts. 3. Minimum BC grade in Minor course of VI Semester. 4. Student should not have received 'Z' grade in any of the courses of VI Semester.
Award of Minor Degree	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Minimum BC grade in Minor course of VII Semester. 2. At the end of VII Semester, students should not have any live backlogs from V and VI Semesters. If he/she has live backlogs from V and VI Semester, he/she should get it clear in the immediate Make Up exam.
