

11th November 2014 was the birth anniversary of Shri Maulana Abdul Kalam Azad, a great freedom fighter and the 1st Union Education Minister of free India. SOCIALITICS FOR INSTITUTIONAL SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

In general, 'politics' was closely associated with the term dirty by majority of Indian population. However, recently, unprecedented factors like corruption, development, expectations and hope (and not the usual poverty, caste and regional issues) took priority. These factors which are directly associated with electricity, drinking water, health, education, safety and security, employment and roads etc., hit the mindsets of Indian population. First time in the history of Indian elections, not only the progressive manifestos but the proven track records of politicians were also the decisive factors for voting. High-tech campaign, electronic and social media and the organizational structure has redefined their applicability, impact and contribution that changed the scene dramatically. The million dollar question throughout the election campaign was who can deliver? Amongst possible options, Mr. N. D. Modi, our Hon'ble PM, was then the unanimous but democratic, choice by the people of India who voted for change (transformation). The functioning of the government therefore, is expected to be the development centric and in line with the theme of elections 2014.

Politics was once thought to be a derivative of social sciences based on contemporary civilizations and the lives of the native people. It had, for some decades, lost its glory, majorly due to loyalty and other factors. Social work and politics appeared to be marginally separated by thin line. However, a reestablished (but long awaited) trend which includes the politics of development shows society driven healthy politics. And therefore, it is an evident to predict inclination of technology driven political methods towards urgent and important socio-economic requirements. The

politics of development thus can be rephrased as 'socialitics'.

This is for sure that the politics of development (socialitics), will lead to some reliable and sustainable models of development in the process of transformation. It should, however, be ensured that the availability of the resources, mechanisms, tools and techniques to achieve these transformations should start with ethics and values, and end with standardized critical reviews of outcomes. Moreover, as far as applicability of these models is concerned, they remain to be universal and can be deployed globally, provided integration of such models are established through adequate coordination. The only difference at implementation stage shall be at the level of scale from micro, medium to mega and sometimes there may be additional few variables like demography, process etc. which can be eventually overcome right at the planning stage.

For instance, a crane or hoist can be designed for lifting a load of 100 kg and its structurally strong but similar mega model can be used to lift a weight of 1000 tonnes. Hence from miniature to mega structures, merely scales and magnitudes of applications may differ however, the technique driving the corresponding technology remains unchanged. Accepting the similar facts of the nature from atomic particles to universal galaxies, it's a matter of mapping, vision and approach.

In line with the above discussion, one of such model can be established by exercising the politics of development (socialitics) for a tribal village in India or Maharashtra in particular

Development of Modern Tribal Indian Village

India have been accepted as one of the most important issues to the Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) as well as all the present and the previous Government(s) of India. There had been several planned or unplanned, methodical or random attempts made, in order to empower the tribal people and/or to make the tribal village to be self-sufficient and self-reliant. Various methods, schemes, equipments and mechanisms were devised and implemented by allocating significant percentageshare of the budget (or GDP) in this regard. Several papers and study reports by eminent researchers as well as government's official documents published also show that substantial progress has been made in the decades after independence.

In all the previous and ongoing efforts in this direction, the care has been taken to maintain (or disturb least) the glory of tribal culture and traditions. The core objectives emphasized to attain the empowerment leading to tribal self-sufficiency were health, education, sports, electricity, social and political awareness, agriculture etc. There had been either the partial focus or the poor program outcomes towards attaining the availability of drinking water, empowerment by skill development, poorly managed processing-storage-marketing of the forest produce

Development of Tribal villages and tribal people of etc. There can be some agreement or disagreement on figures related with Tribal Development Index (TDI) in general. However, it can be predominantly identified that these efforts are distributed, scattered and carried out by separate agencies at various times, almost without appropriate coordination and thereby spending exorbitant money. A techno-socioeconomic model to develop a modern Tribal Indian Village can therefore be envisioned considering integration of technologies and Public-Private-Institutions-Government partnership involving the

> If, we hope to see some functional models obtained from 'socialitics' in the near future, then we must understand our responsibility and anticipate the role to play. The first step to do so would be to bring all under the umbrella of "Institutional Social Responsibility" and make them contribute on the basis of their expertise. The well-targeted efforts for food, drinking water, electricity, shelters, employment and security to the modern tribal village will definitely be possible when the engineers and managers of the modern world determines to do so.


